Cabernet Sauvignon 2006

At Kaesler we have 3 Cabernet Vineyards; two on the original Kaesler farm, and one from Barrington's, over the main road from Kaesler.

The soil type on all the sites is red brown loam over clay and then over limestone rubble and is perfectly suited for Cabernet Sauvignon. The clay builds the fruit and strength into the wine, and limestone the finer tannins.

Our 2006 Cabernet was matured in new and one & two year old French oak for 15 months. The wine was neither fined nor filtered.

Colour: Ruby and dense garnet

Nose: Strong up-front blackberry and spice box with toasty characters. Old fashioned in style

Palate: Firm tannin, dark berries, intense with a long finish. Opulent palate with great structure

Notes Cabernet Sauvignon is seriously under rated in Barossa. Our 2006 Cabernet is one our best to date and should drink well over the next 10 years.

Age of vines: Blend of estate plantings average age 35 years
