Viognier 2009

Pronounced Vee-on-yay

We grow 3 acres of Viognier. This is the fifth of this of this wine and we only make 300 dozen. It is lovingly known at the winery as “Steve’s Love Child”. Steve is our winemaker who has a bit of a passion for the variety.

The grapes were whole bunch pressed with all of the pressings being included. Juice was fermented in stainless steel tanks with 100% wild yeast and left on lees for two months. The wine was then racked and pumped into French oak 15% new and the remainder 2 & 3 year old oak. The wine remained in oak for a further 6 months.

Colour: light straw colour

Nose: Aromatic stonefruits, fresh pineapple, slightly spicy

Palate: Creamy and full flavoured mouthfeel, but with crisp fruit characters like new season nectarines and apricots. Clean finish, not to cloying.

Notes: A powerful wine that is ideal with food – serve well chilled and try it with cheese, fresh fruit, veal dishes.

Age of vines: Estate plantings of 8 year old Viognier

Alc: 15.0%
