2001 Stonehorse Grenache Shiraz Mouvedre

The Stonehorse vineyards are some of the oldest in the Barossa. The parcels of Grenache and Mouvedre that were used for this wine were planted in the 1930's and the Shiraz was from a vineyard planted in 1990.

The Stonehorse Grenache Shiraz Mouvedre style is typified with maturation in older barrels, normally 3 to 5 years old. This creates a style that emphasises the fruit flavours of the three varieties and delivers a medium bodied wine with the capacity to pair well with a wide variety of foods.

The 2001 growing season was the hottest since 1904 and allowed the vines to achieve maximum ripeness. Grenache Shiraz and Mouvedre, particularly from older vines thrive in these conditions and always give maximum flavour

Tasting Notes

- Colour:** Rich and dense with clear purple colours in its youth
- Nose:** Concoction of Mulberry, Prune, Dried Fig. Mocha overtones
- Palate:** Punchy fruit, and medium bodied in weight.
- Comments:** The blend break down is Grenache 77%, Shiraz 15% and Mouvedre 8%. This wine will age over the next 5 years but its is best drunk young to maximise the full fruit flavours
